PPK Processing using the GCGC Reference Data Shop

The Gulf Coast Geospatial Center (GCGC) Reference data shop provides GNSS base station data files for each of its 52 Continuously Operating Reference Stations (CORS), with data continuously logged at each CORS at 1-second intervals. The reference coordinates of each CORS are relative to **NAD83 (2011)** and are established using the Online Positioning User Service (OPUS) through the National Geodetic Survey (NGS). These files can be used in Post-Processed Kinematic (PPK) positioning workflows as static base station data.

- 1. Access the reference data shop at **rtn.usm.edu**.
 - a. If you have not previously registered, select **Register** to create an account. Account setup will be confirmed via email.
 - b. Select **Login** if you are a previously registered user and log in using your email and password.
 - c. (To reset your password, contact gcgctech@usm.edu)
- 2. In the navigation menu (dialogue box on left side), select Reference Data Shop.
- 3. Select Start a new order.
- 4. Choose Continuously Operating Reference Station (CORS).

5. Use the map to select a reference station by clicking on the nearest green pin to your survey location, or by selecting a reference station from the list.

Reference Data Shop - Reference Stations

Choose one or more reference stations by clicking in the list or in the map. If you want to select multiple stations from the list, press and hold down the CTRL key and click with the mouse.



6. Select **Next: Time Selection** from the bottom of the Map dialogue box.



7. Enter the desired start date, start time and duration for your reference file in Coordinated Universal Time (UTC). The start time of your reference file should be before the start time of your survey, and the duration should be long enough so that the reference file encompasses the entire survey time from beginning to end. The time interval of GNSS observations in seconds can also be specified on this page.
