The Fulbright Scholar program:

- is the flagship international educational exchange program sponsored by the U.S. government.
- is designed to increase mutual understanding between the people of the United States and the people of other countries.
- is funded annually through appropriations made by the U.S. Congress to the U.S. Department of State, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs.
- recipients are selected on the basis of academic or professional achievement, as well as demonstrated leadership potential in their fields.

As a Fulbright Scholar, Dr. Cole will serve as a lecturer and will conduct research in Lithuania at ISM University of Management and Economics. Dr. Cole joins an elite group of Fulbright alumni including 37 who have served as heads of state or government, 60 from 14 countries who have been awarded the Nobel Prize, 72 MacArthur Foundation Fellows, and 86 who have received Pulitzer Prizes. We are very proud of Dr. Cole and look forward to the impact she will make through her research in Lithuania and beyond.
