

Quality Matters – Self Review

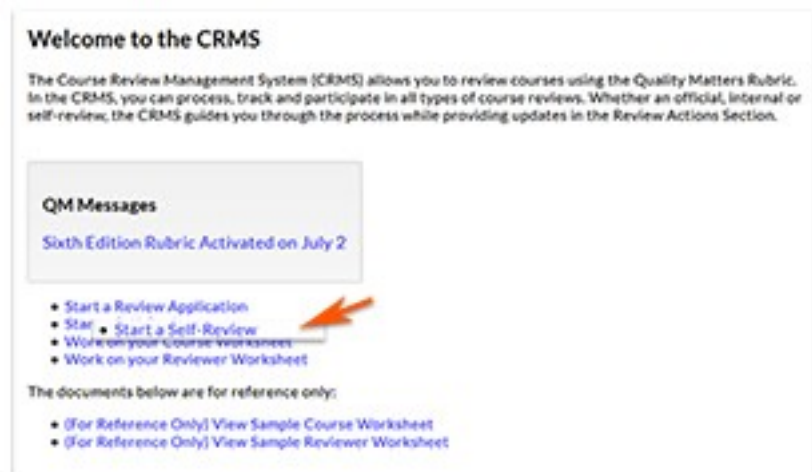

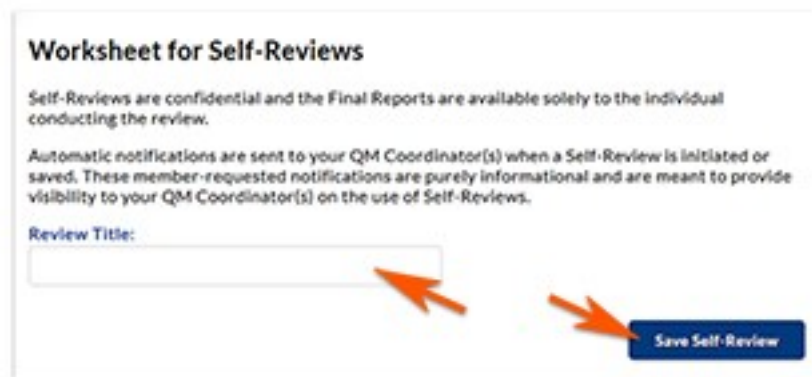
