The University of Southern Mississippi Instructions for the CITI Course in the Integrity Assurance Program

Completion time will vary, depending on your reading speed and whether you follow all of the links. The basic Research Integrity modules each take about 15-25 minutes to complete. If you are taking the case study courses, these modules each take about 5-8 minutes which will amount to approximately 4-6 hours total completion time. Videos require Microsoft Media Player, Real Player plug-in, or Quick Time, and some of the documents require Acrobat Reader.

- 1. Begin at <u>https://www.citiprogram.org/default.asp?language=english</u>.This is where you will register as a new user and login.
- 2. Follow these instructions if you have never registered for a CITI course (if you have registered, go to step 3):
 - At "Create an account" click on **<u>Register</u>**.
 - Complete Registration Steps 1-7 (Type in University of Southern Mississippi as your institution or organization.)
 - Continue to Step 2
 - Complete the personal information form. (If you are a USM faculty/staff, enter your Campus ID number in the Employee Number block; if you are a USM student, enter your student ID number in this space.)
 - Continue to Step 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7
- 3. Once you have completed the initial registration you will login using your username and password and follow the steps below.
 - Click on <u>Add a course or update your learner groups</u> for The University of Southern Mississippi
 - Choose the following courses suited to your program requirements, then click on submit
 - Question 1 Common Course for USM Graduate Students
 - Question 4 Human Subjects Research Course
